As the new academic session has begun, please note the following:

- School Almanac (Student's Diary) has been distributed in all the classes and you are requested to fill the required details on Page Nos. 3,5,7,9 and 11. You must deposit Page Nos. 5 & 7 with the Class Teacher through your ward on or before 05th April, 2023. Please read Page Nos. 14 and 17 - 23 thoroughly and ensure compliance to the school norms by your ward/s.
- You are requested to go through important instructions for students of classes IX to XII, and ensure adherence to the school rules strictly.
- The school has added 'My Weekly Gratitude Journal' and 'My Reflections' pages in the Student's diary. You are requested to ensure that your ward fills these pages every week. Your support will help us to inculcate the virtue of gratitude and the habit of reflection on one's actions and thoughts in the young learners, which are very important to lead a happy life.
- School Fee has been updated on the school website and you are requested to pay the same by 15th April, 2023 using the Feebank app to avoid Late Fee Fine.

- It has been observed that after the pandemic, a large number of parents have started dropping and picking up their wards in their own vehicles. This leads to a lot of rush on the roads as well as at the school gates in the morning and at the dispersal time. The school has received numerous complaints from the residents of the area about the same. Keeping our concern for the environment, the parents are requested to avail the services of the school owned buses and/or the private transport hired by the school. It is a cheaper and environment-friendly mode of commuting to the school. Plus, it will help your wards have better camaraderie and be independent in the long run. We seek your cooperation in this regard.
- The school has 'zero tolerance' for late reporting of the students as it hampers the inculcation of value of punctuality and time management in the students. The parents are requested to get their wards ready well in time, so that they are inside the campus before the school gates are closed. This will ensure a peaceful start of the day and they will be able to concentrate better on the academic work.
- In order to manage dispersal of the students effectively the school uses three gates i.e. gate no. 1, 3 and 4, for the students of different classes. The students who are picked up by their parents report at the designated gates. You are requested to use the gates as per the details given below:

Students of classes **3rd, 4th, 5th & 7th** - at **Gate no. 3** on the **temple side**.

Students of classes **6th & 8th** - at **Gate No. 4** on the **canal side**.

Students of classes **9th & 10th** - at **Gate no 1 (main gate)**

Gate no. 2 is designated for the school buses alone.

You are requested not to park your car/ scooter etc. in front of gate no. 2.

- Please be on time to pick up your wards and park your vehicles in an orderly manner to ensure free flow of traffic.
