Greetings!

**“Until we can manage time, we can’t manage anything”.**

Please note the following:

- The school timings were changed from 19<sup>th</sup> April 2023 and now the school starts at **7:30 am**. It has been observed that many **parents keep reaching the school gates till 7:40 am** or even beyond. As a result the students report late in the classes and this affects their work. You are requested to drop your wards before 7:30 am so that the students are seated in the classrooms before the start of the school. Please note that from **5<sup>th</sup> May 2023, gates will be closed at 7:30 am sharp and any student reporting late will not be taken in and will have to go back.**
- It has been observed that many **boys of Classes IX upwards do not tuck in their shirts in their trousers** to wear a smart look and they have to be repeatedly intercepted by the teachers. You are hereby requested to kindly check your ward and firmly instruct him **to follow norms of the school in totality. Parents and school play a vital role in shaping the personality of the children.**
- It has also been observed that **many senior girls are supporting long hair but cut flicks in the front**, which keep on falling on their faces. They spend more time managing such hair styles instead of concentrating on the work being transacted in the classroom. You are requested to **ensure that your wards get a decent haircut and manage their long hair in braided form, securing the flicks with the hairpins.**
