Please read and follow the guidelines given below carefully:

**1. Set Your Goals** – *“A goal without a plan is just a wish.”*

- Define clear **long-term (year-end) goals** for your academic performance as well as personal development.
- Break them into **short-term weekly and monthly goals** so that your progress becomes measurable and achievable.
- Prepare a **personal study schedule** and follow it sincerely to stay organized and focused.
- Review your goals regularly and make improvements wherever necessary.
- NOTE – I'm always available in case you need help or support in setting your goals.

**2. Be Regular and Punctual** – *“Success is the sum of small efforts, repeated day in and day out.”*

- Regularity and punctuality are the **foundation of discipline and success** in life.
- Attend school **every day without fail** and ensure that you are **on time for morning assembly and every class**.
- Missing school leads to gaps in learning, which are difficult to cover later.
- **Absence or late reporting without a valid reason will lead to a fine of ₹100 per day**, so take your attendance seriously.

**3. Uniform & Grooming** – *“Simplicity is the ultimate sophistication.”*

- Always come to school in **complete and proper uniform**, reflecting pride in your institution.
- Maintain **personal hygiene** - clean nails, polished shoes, and tidy appearance contribute to good health and confidence.
- Ensure a **neat and well-groomed look** every day.

- Girls must avoid long ponytails—**two plaits up to Class IX and one plait in Classes X to XII.**
- **Nail paint, nail extensions, or any form of artificial grooming is not permitted.**
- Boys must keep their hair **short, simple, and well-maintained** at all times.

#### 4. Mobile Phones – *“Discipline is choosing between what you want now and what you want most.”*

- **Mobile phones are strictly not allowed** inside the school premises.
- The school is a place for focused learning, and mobile phones cause unnecessary distraction.
- Any student found carrying or using a mobile phone will have it **confiscated for the entire session.**
- Learn to **stay present and engaged** in your classroom environment.
- Become mentally strong, build resilience – do not suffer from FOMO.

#### 5. School Bags

- Carry **lightweight school bags** to avoid undue strain and to maintain good posture.
- Bring only the **required books and notebooks** as per the timetable or instructions given by your class teacher.
- Being organized will help you manage your studies more efficiently and reduce unnecessary burden.

#### 6. No Bunking – *“Learning is life and there is better life inside the classroom than outside it.”*

- **Bunking any class is a serious disciplinary offence** and will not be tolerated.
- It disrupts your learning and reflects irresponsibility, and leads to wastage of time, effort and money.
- A fine of **₹1000 per class** per student will be imposed for bunking.
- Attendance will be taken **in every period by all subject teachers**, so ensure you attend each class sincerely.

#### 7. Weekly Journal Writing – *“Reflect on your present blessings, of which every person has many.”*

- Maintain a **weekly journal** using the gratitude and reflection section provided in your almanac.
- This practice will help you develop **self-awareness, positivity, and emotional growth.**

- Write honestly about your experiences, achievements, and areas of improvement.
- Your journal will be **evaluated during the Mid-Term and Final Term**, and marks will be included in your **internal assessment (Classes III–XII)**.

## 8. Travel Guidelines
